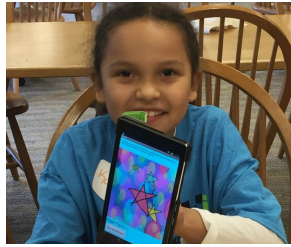
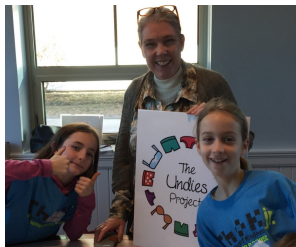
QWASI is excited work with Random Hacks of Kindness Jr to bring technology to the younger generation.
